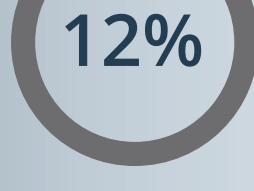

SO... how common are pedestrian accidents in the United States?

1 Pedestrian accidents occur every **7 minutes** nationwide



In 2013, **4,735** Pedestrians died nationwide

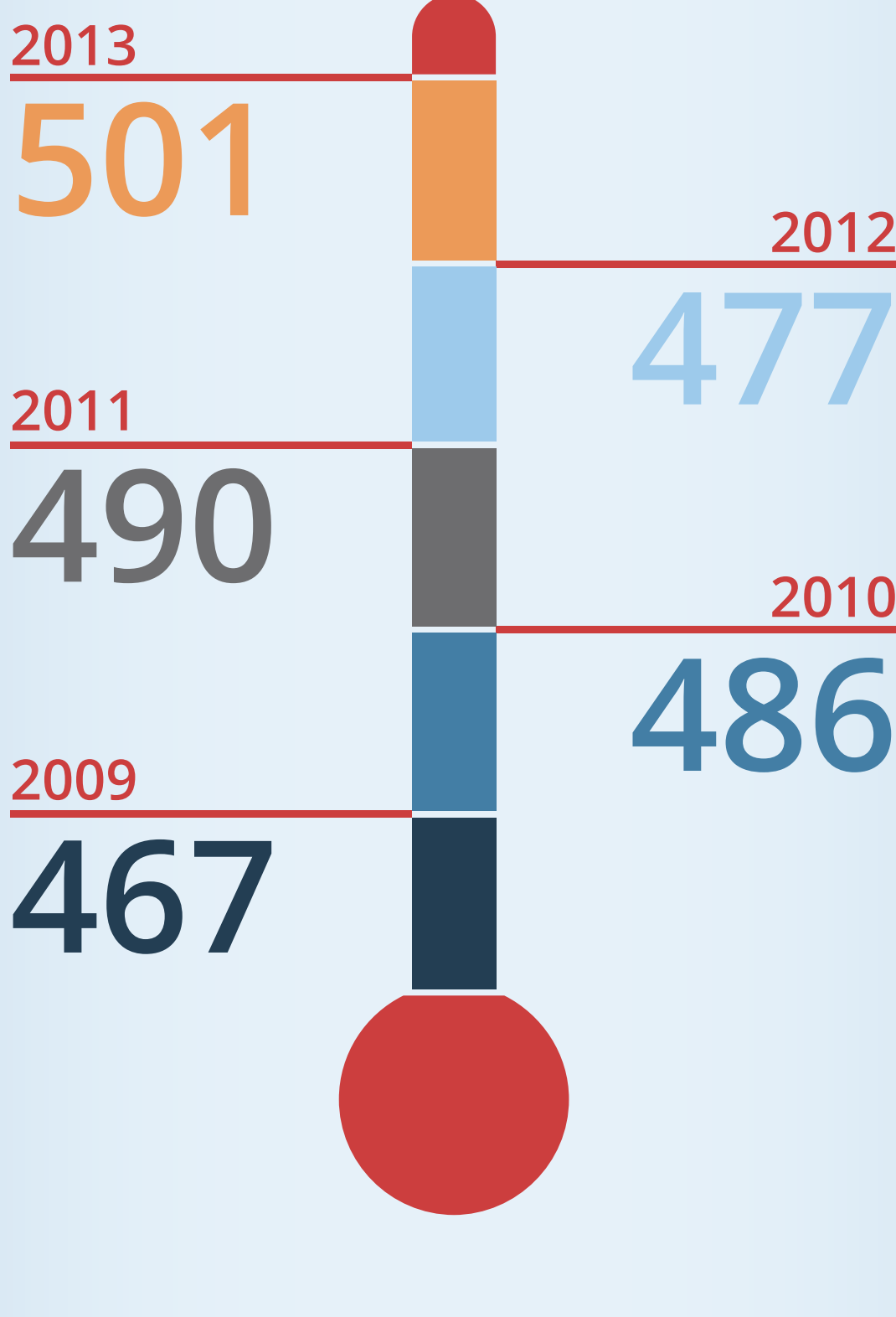


Nationwide
12% of traffic fatalities are pedestrian deaths

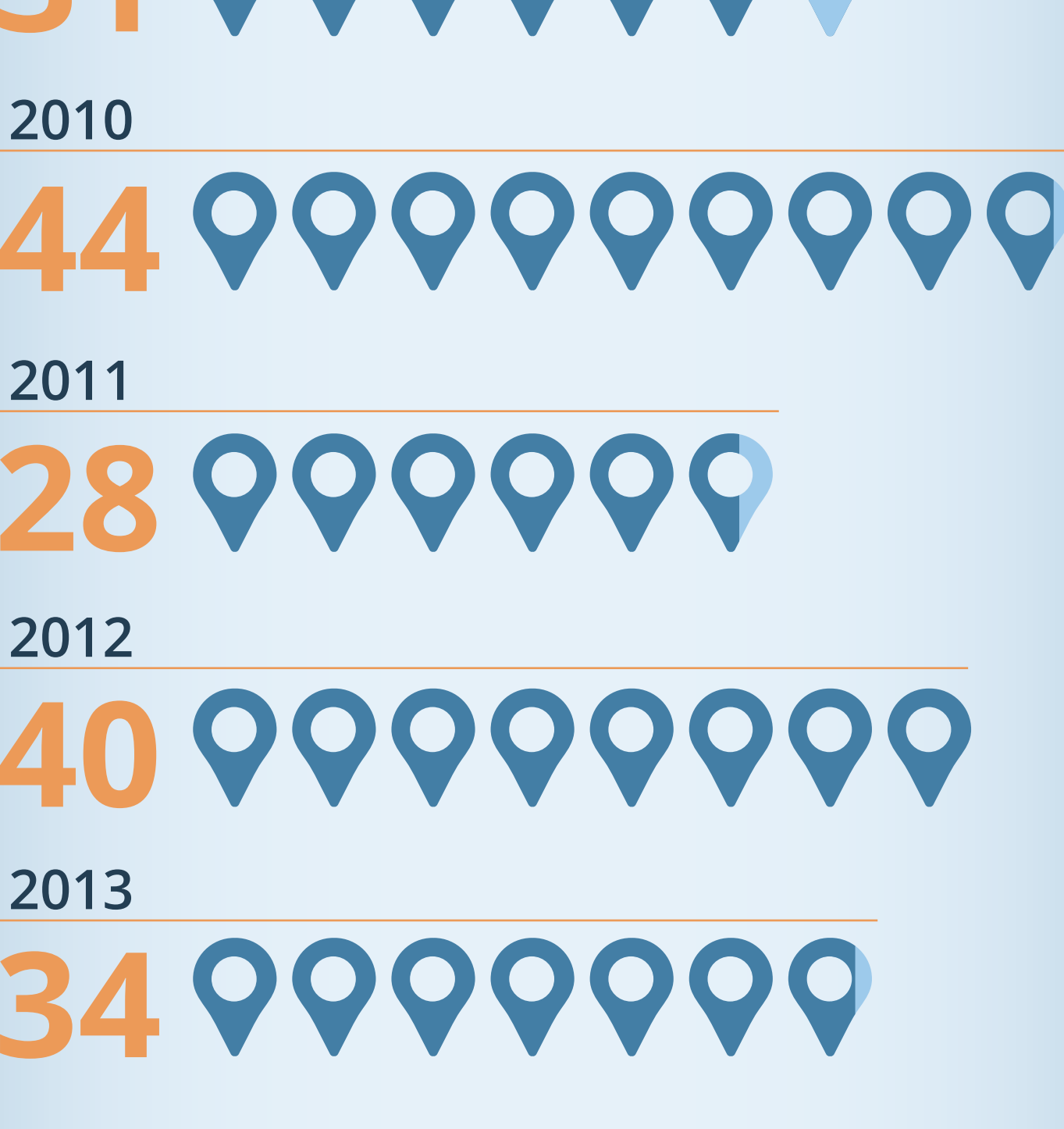
BUT... In Florida, pedestrian deaths account for **20%**

of all traffic fatalities

Florida Pedestrian Fatalities

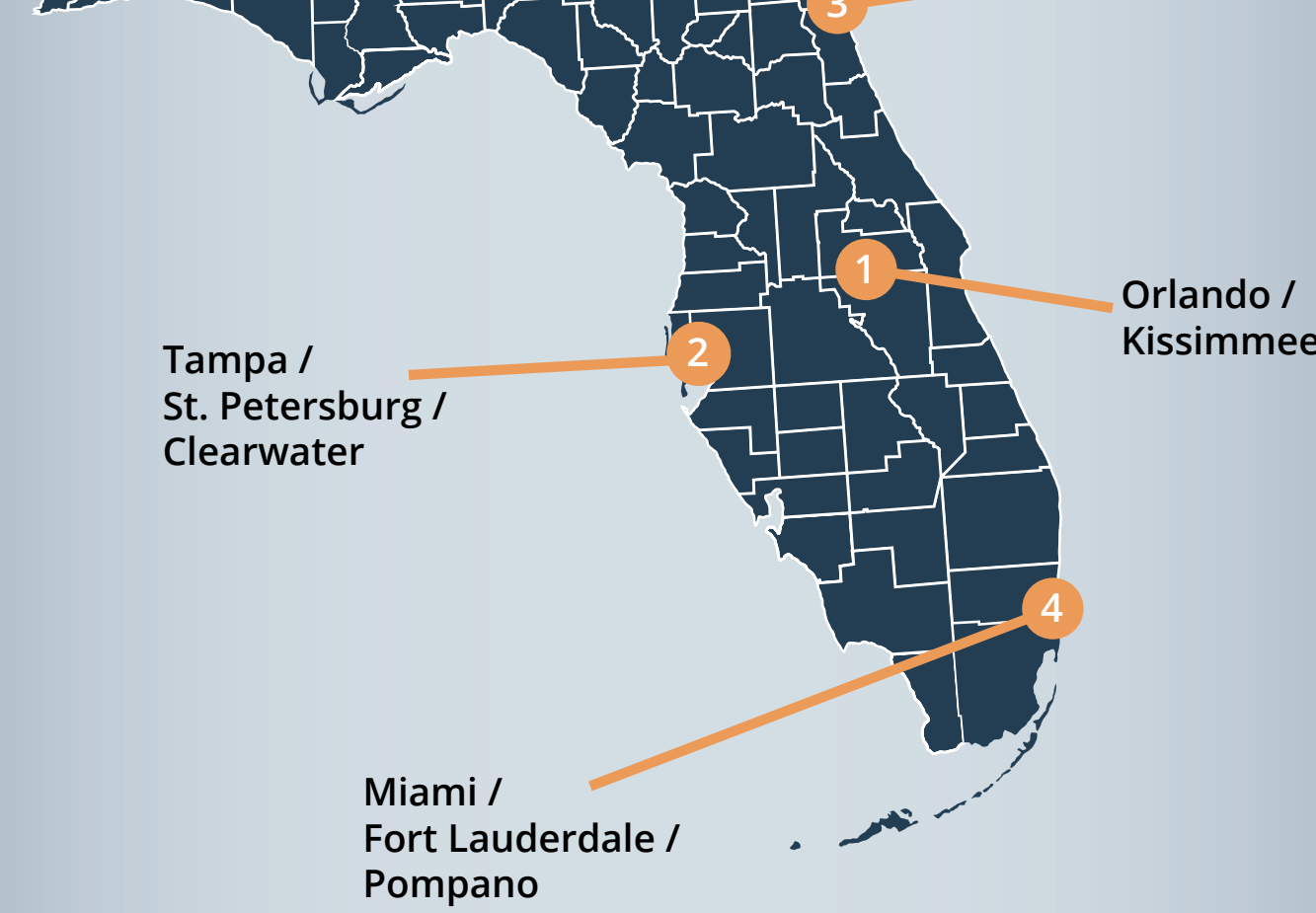


Orlando, Florida Pedestrian Fatalities
