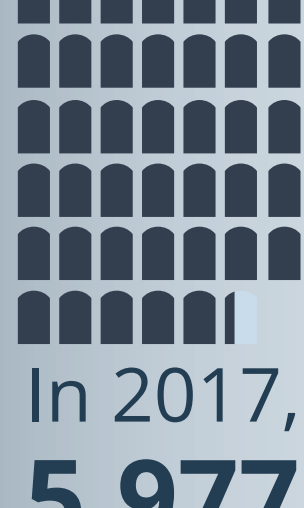

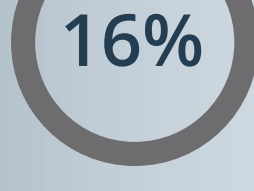

**1** Pedestrian accidents occur every **7 minutes** nationwide



In 2017, **5,977** Pedestrians died nationwide



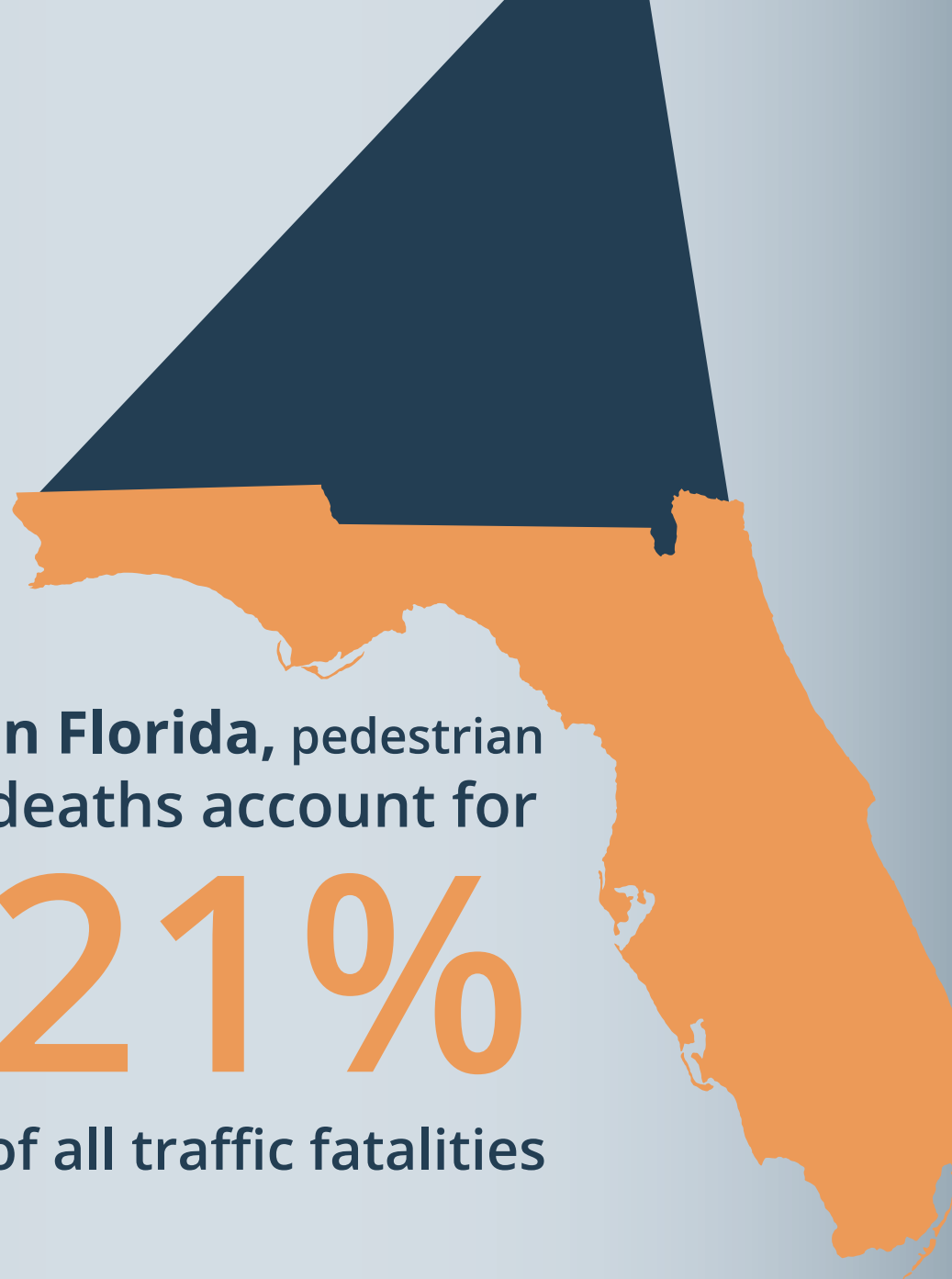
**Nationwide**  
16% of traffic fatalities are pedestrian deaths

**BUT...**

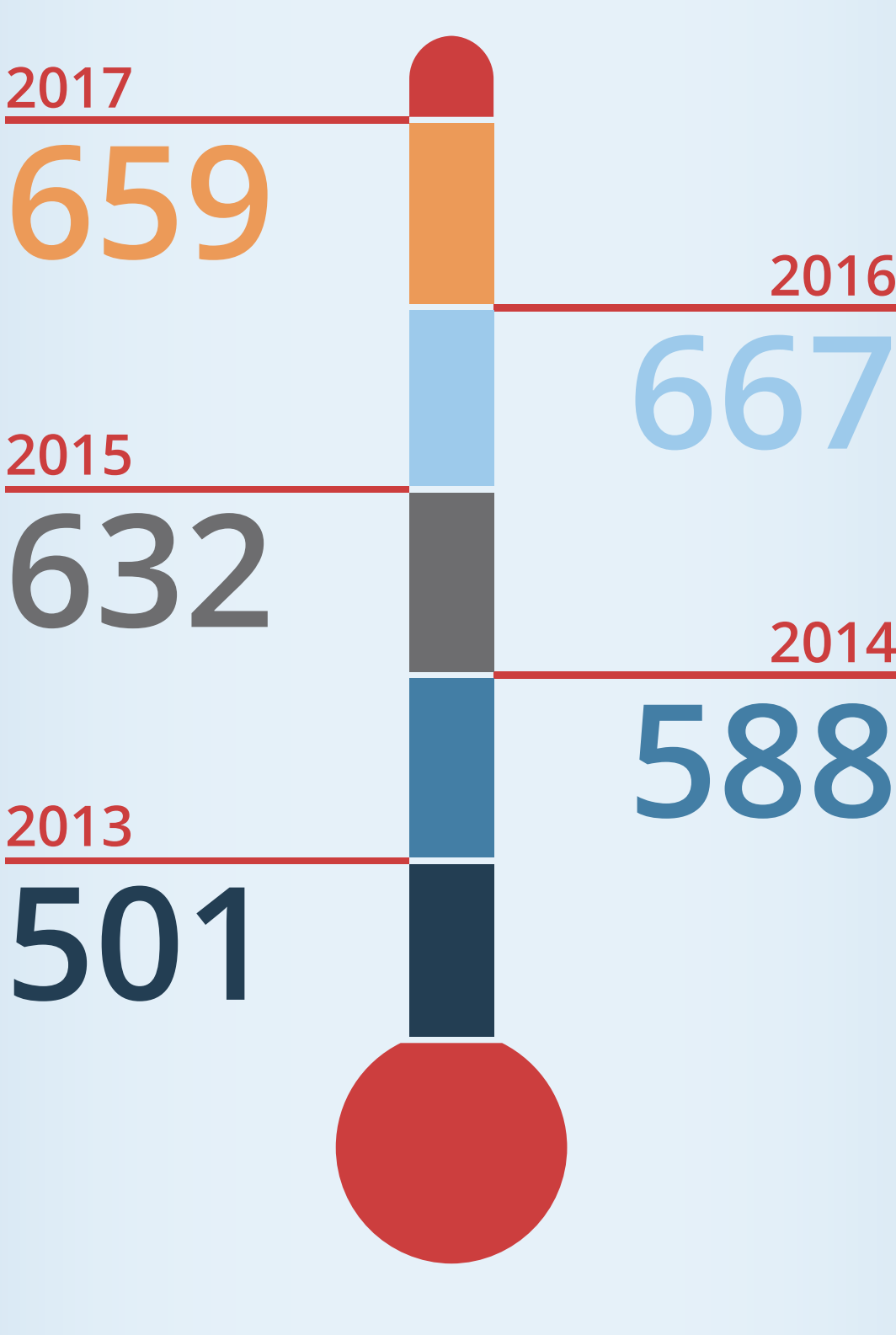
In Florida, pedestrian deaths account for

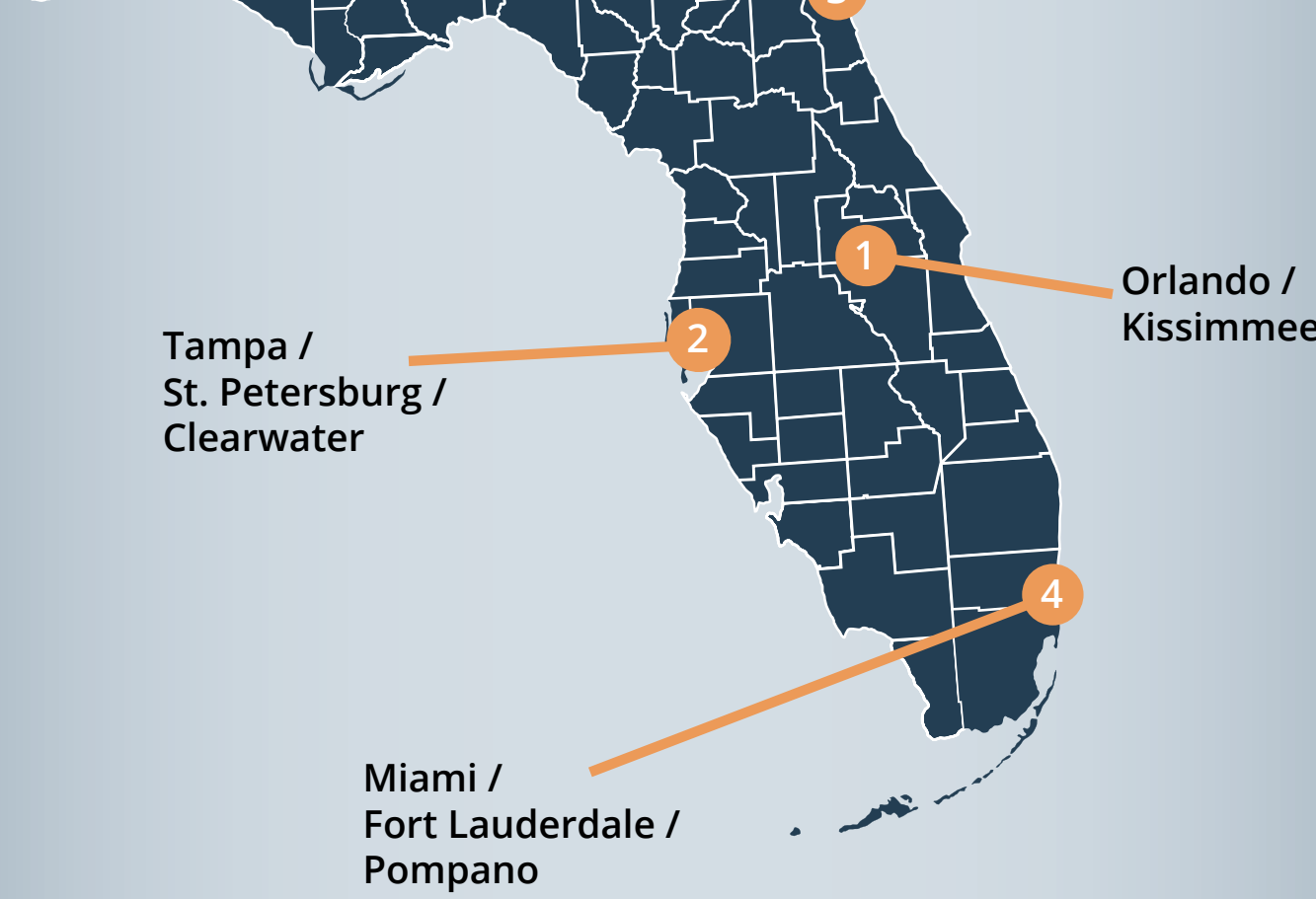

... but Orlando is not the only dangerous city

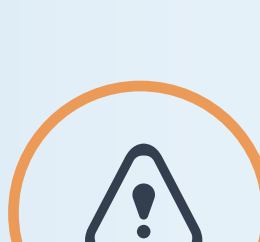


Florida alone has **4 cities** ranked worst for **pedestrian accidents** across the United States
